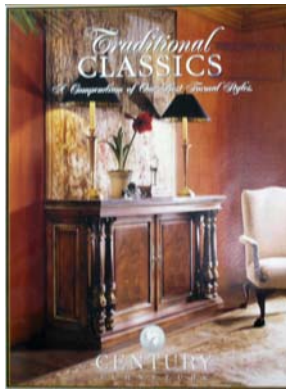
They have two new catalogs: the first combines their best causal styles, and the second combines the best from there traditional styles.

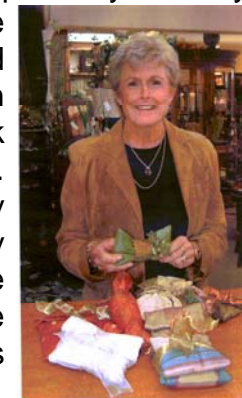


*Traditional Classics*
