My History in Home Furnishing Shows:
“BUYER BEWARE”

In the late 60's and early 70's, furniture manufactures started making all the carvings on wood furniture out of plastic stained to look like wood. Sometimes, entire headboards were not made of wood but were in fact plastic that was poured into a mold and made to look like wood. In the 80's, upholstered furniture frames were classified as hardwood frames, but in reality many times the arms were molded plastic connected with boards of hardwood. The quality of foam and Dacron wrapping in upholstered cushions was being made with inferior materials compared to their predecessors. **In today's market of manufactures selling “ONLY ON PRICE” I expect to see the quality fall again.** With the introduction of resins, which is an effective material for accessory items such as lamps and picture frames, I am hoping that this material does not

become a significant part of furniture manufacturing. In my 40 years of design, I have always sought out the manufacturers that fought the economy— not by cutting the quality of their product— but by coming up with more innovative ideas to make their products with appealing features, such as hiding a cell phone charger in your nightstand. I will be going to market in North Carolina again this April. I will find you the highest quality for the best value by doing serious research on the manufacturers presented there.
